The program is the first postgraduate Islamic banking and finance program offered by a public institute of higher learning. This program is conducted within 18 - 24 months for completion. This program is also recognized by IBFIM where upon completion of the program, students may be awarded a professional certification, Associate Qualification in Islamic Finance (AQIF). Students may apply to obtain the certification with minimum fee. Candidates with non-Shariah background but are interested to embark on the program will have to attend and pass an executive program organized by AAGBS during the first semester.
