Synopsis

The Master's programme in Accountancy began in 1996 as a joint collaborative program between UiTM and Curtin University of Technology, Australia. Since 1999, the collaborative program has evolved into UiTM's own Master of Accountancy programme. This program aims to educate students to be critical, analytical, and ethical at the managerial level. Students may register either for full-time or part-time study for the Master of Accountancy.

Entry Requirement

General

i. Bachelor's Degree in Accountancy (Honours) from UiTM or any Institution of Higher Learning (recognized by UiTM Senate) with a minimum CGPA of 2.75;

OR

ii. Bachelor's Degree in Accountancy (Honours) from UiTM or any Institution of Higher Learning (recognized by UiTM Senate) with a minimum CGPA of 2.50 and a minimum working experience of 3 years;

OR

iii. Bachelor's Degree in the related fields with a minimum CGPA of 3.00 or equivalent and must undergo appropriate prerequisite courses determined by the faculty.

OR

iv. Bachelor's Degree in the related fields with a minimum CGPA of 2.75 and a minimum working experience of 3 years and must undergo appropriate prerequisite courses determined by the faculty.

OR

v. Professional Accounting Qualification (ACCA, CPA(Australia), CIMA, MICPA, ICAEW, or equivalent) recognized by UiTM Senate:

Candidate Selection:

Candidates without qualification in the related fields or relevant working experience must undergo appropriate prerequisite courses determined by the HEP and meet the minimum CGPA based on (iii) to (iv).
