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Dean's Message

AS an individual, the end of the year is always the best time to reflect on our achievements. Unfortunately, for most of us, the past 20 months has disrupted our lives socially and economically due to Covid-19 pandemic. However, its business as usual for IPSis in terms of recruitment and promotion for new postgraduate students as well as other academic matters with some adjustment to the new normal.

The new intake for 2021 has set a new record for IPSis with 5026 students and this has make us on top of the list compared with other public universities in Malaysia. Consequently, our postgraduate enrolment has increased to 10822 (as of 31 December 2021) which is the highest since IPSis establishment. This year, we have also surpassed our target of 1000 international enrolment with 1262 students.

The challenge now is to ensure all the new students complete their studies and graduate. Although there will be some attrition along the journey, we hope that with excellent academic program, research facilities, effective supervision and intervention from faculties, this attrition rate will be very minimal. Synergy between IPSis and faculties, state campuses and academic centers is essential to achieve this aspiration.



Finally, this success is for everyone and merely the start of my adventurous new life.




