




As of 11<sup>th</sup> May 2022, the total post-graduate enrolment has reached 10,813 and the number is contributed mostly (85.8%) by the local students.












The top five faculties with highest enrolment are the College of Engineering, Arshad Ayub Graduate Business School, Faculty of Business and Management, College of Creative Arts and Faculty of Architecture, Planning and Surveying.



Comparing the data from March 2018 to March 2022, it clearly shows a reducing number (29.8 %) of applications received. However, the number of offers made and total registration by semester is rather fluctuating with the percentage of offers compared to number of applications varies between 18.3 percent to 70.3 percent while the percentage of registered students also varies between 35.6 percent to 69.5 percent.

Programmes offered by the faculty of Business and Management became the top three programmes in terms of its popularity in 2018. However, the Faculty of Business and Management remains among the top five in the ranking with four of its programmes became the top in the list of five. Research programmes in engineering has gained attention in 2020 and became the top 2 and five for electrical and mechanical engineering, respectively.

A different pattern emerged again in 2021 whereby the College of Creative Arts, the Faculty of Business and Management, and Arshad Ayub Graduate Business School has dominated the chart and the year 2022 has again shows an interesting change when one of the programmes offered by the Faculty of Education come into the play of becoming the third most popular programme

Overall, data from the Admission and Intake has shown an encouraging pattern resulting from the commitment given by all parties involved. Together we strive towards achieving the aspiration of becoming the globally renowned university.








## Hooding Ceremony PhD Graduands




## IPSis Silver fubilee Celebration: Iftar with the


The Post-Graduate Research Symposium 2022 (PEERS'22) was successfully organised on 5 March 2022 at Universiti Teknologi MARA's Faculty of Computer and Mathematical Sciences (FSKM) in Shah Alam. It was coordinated by the Centre of Information Systems Studies, or Pusat Pengajian Sistem Maklumat (PPSM) and Center of Postgraduate Studies, FSKM. Faculty of Computer and Mathematical Sciences (FSKM), Universiti Teknologi MARA (UiTM) Shah Alam lecturers embark with collaborative teaching and learning delivery through industrial talks in Master academic courses started October 2020. For semester October 2021 – February 2022 academic session, the guest lecturer session continued for Master programmes in FSKM. The industrial talks were delivered through webinars which involved esteem invited speakers from the industry and international experts. The webinar sessions were the initiative of two master programmes at which are Master of Data Science, Master of Science in Applied Statistics and Master of Science In Cybersecurity And Digital Forensics. The entire event was a collaborative effort from the lecturers of FSKM and postgraduate students.

#### The China-Asean 5G & IR 4.0 Summit

#### Forum

In the mid of May, The South-East Asia Hainan-Hongkong Express Cable System (SEA-H2X) comes into force. The SEA-H2X cable system consists of at least 8-fiber pairs between Hong Kong SAR and Singapore, with a design capacity of 160 Tbps to meet the growing bandwidth requirement in the region. This submarine cable connects Hong Kong SAR China, Hainan China, the Philippines, Thailand, Malaysia (Borneo Island), and Singapore, with options to extend to Vietnam, Cambodia, Malaysia Peninsula, and Indonesia. The SEA-H2X cable system is targeted to be ready-for-service in 2024, which will effectively meet the demand for network bandwidth and high-speed connectivity in Asia, helping to build a new network ecosystem for 5G evolution, providing a greater boost to the flourishing ASEAN digital industry.

The China-Asean 5G & IR 4.0 Summit Forum, a joint venture between Asia China Education & Cultural Association (ACEC) and Huawei, China's leading global provider of Information and communications technology, is co-organised by Universiti Teknologi MARA (UiTM) and the university's excellent centre, Malaysia Institute of Transport (MITRANS). Other organisations that joins UiTM in co-organising the forum include China-ASEAN Alliance of Universities for Electronic Information Innovation of CAIH (CAAUEII), Asia Centre for Leadership and Civilisation (ACLC) and BRI Culture Centre (BRICC).

The forum was successfully held at Huawei Technology Centre Kuala Lumpur the past Saturday at 10am! The combined online and offline forum attracted many scholars and experts from the ASEAN countries to join the event. This was a fantastic platform to share and learn more about the technology wave's innovation and talent upgrading opportunities!

The Vice Chancellor of UiTM, Professor Datuk Ts. Dr. Hajah Roziah Mohd Janor, in her opening speech indicates that the forum is an important platform for discussion, collecting innovative ideas and practical solutions for digital transformation, especially in the 5G era. She says UiTM is riding the waves of IR4.0 and aspires to lead in the transformation process.

"UiTM is currently active in doing research related to various fields including analytics, machine learning and artificial intelligence. We have outstanding researchers who successfully secured both national and international grants, for example, recently UiTM researchers secured an industry grant in Digital Sandbox leveraging Big Data analysis to perform cyber security track venison from Data Sonic Berhad. Recently, we also embark on assurance analytics, a project focuses on big data analytic aspects of auditing, planning to implement sustainable data analytic in auditing."
